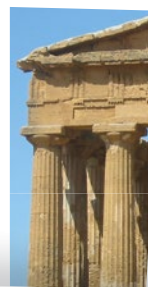

Archaeological research & discovery of knowledge & flavors of Sicily



Kalat is a project of tourism, research & discovery promoted in Sicily since 1995, which has so far involved more than 1000 youngsters fans, archaeologists, foreign & local researchers in XVII editions of International Summer Camps. After the complete recognition of the whole Campobello's territory & the discovery of more than 270 areas of archaeological interest, since this year Kalat offers a real breakthrough: the traditional Kalat's International Summer Camps are now becoming international youth HAPPENINGS.

The international youth HAPPENINGS are proposed, in fact, as an exciting new formula of youth tourism & an innovative initiative of local development which combines the passion of archaeological researches -in lands confiscated from mafia-, with the discovery of knowledge & flavors of Sicily, the interest of art workshops & guided tours, the entertainment of musical moments & the enjoyment of the Mediterranean sea at Licata.

This activities -aimed to a touristic & cultural reconversion of the territory-, are made possible thanks to the support of *Fondazione con il Sud*, the scientific advice of the Master's Degree in Archaeology of the University of Palermo, the supervision of the Superintendence of Cultural Assets of Agrigento & the collaboration of Libera & Slow Food® and SOAT of Campobello di Licata & Grotte.

SURVEY

Since 2013, Kalat adds, to the value of the exciting archaeological research & discovery, a direct commitment antimafia (in cooperation with Libera), with the research of archaeological sites in lands confiscated from the Mafia. This research activity is not just aimed to Archaeology enthusiasts. Simple & effortless, perfect for keeping in shape, is an activity suitable for people who can enjoy the charm of discovery that only Archeology can give and at the same time for learning the basics of the discipline.

In fact, the participants in the afternoons, walking in the landscapes of the area under the guidance of an expert archaeologist, will proceed neatly in a systematic & controlling the ground. Then they'll sign the possible presence of archaeological material, which have quickly learned to recognize at the beginning of the week. The archaeological material identified will be selected & analyzed besides the archaeologist, who will illustrate the characteristics & specificities. Later will be washed, signed, classified & stored for being later extensively studied by experts & shown in exhibitions.

RECOVERY OF ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS

Also will be continued the recovery of the Bronze Age necropolis of *Iachinu Fili*, one of the rural & more characteristic area of the territory of Campobello di Licata. Its characterized by numerous cave tombs from the Ancient Bronze Age (XXII-XVI centuries BC.), some of which have been reused in the Byzantine period.





Tastings of Typical Products

SICILIAN STREET FOOD

The evening of the arrival is foreseen the first of the tasting moments of typical Sicilian products, carried out in collaboration with Slow Food®: The “street food” are those products of typical tradition which in Sicily can be founded on the streets or at the corners of the city, ready for consumption: *arancini*, *panelle*, *crocché*, *scacce* as well as the local *'mpanate* (puff pastry stuffed with vegetables, broccoli & olives) and pizza *fua-ta* with tomato, cheese, anchovies and black olives



CHEESE

Campobello di Licata has a great quality production of cheeses & ricotta, including an excellent goat cheese production, bio farming products of Girgentane goats, typical animal of the area.

TYPICAL LOCAL DESSERTS

Its foreseen the tastings of the typical to-tomè (done in Ravanusa), the classic raviole with ricotta, crunchy pastries with almonds & honey, as well as the classic cannoli with ricotta, cassata...

Every activity will be accompanied by tastings of the better wines of south-central Sicily



To Licata's beach

Using a comfortable bus service, at the morning the participants can get in 20 minutes to the long & equipped beaches of Licata, where will be done a sand sculpture about antimafia issues.





Prehistoric pottery & painting workshops

The participants, during the camps, also with the help of local artists & artisans, will produce objects/souvenirs with natural elements, tools, materials and dyes... entirely similar to those produced by prehistoric people...

The territory's identity

It's programmed an excursion aimed to understand the typical features of the area: the Girgentana goat, the winery production, the chinks, the culture of almonds & pistachios and a final visit to Ravanusa's archaeological museum. Saturday morning you can also visit the city market. For those who will participate in more than one turn, for the weekend, the organization will suggest short itineraries in some Sicilian destinations, however the costs will be in charge of the participants.



Happening's Moment

INTERNATIONAL DINNER

On the final evening the participants will be required to prepare a typical recipe of their country. Its suggested the preparation of a typical dish preferably cold (so that they can be prepared in advance according to a specific timetable without clogging the kitchen activities), easy to prepare (in order to ensure the success) & with ingredients easily available in the local background.



CONCERT AND SLIDE SHOW

Happening Moments

In the final evening, the participants will be the main characters of a night of good music with local bands & also will relive the week through a video presentation that will immortalize the best moments of the Happening.

Photo contest

Among the participants that Saturday morning will deliver a selection of their digital photos taken during the week, the best of them will be selected & the winners awarded with a selection of the best local products.



Guided Tours of the Valley of the Temples in Agrigento or excursions in neighboring towns

On Sunday morning, we provide guided tours to the Valley of the Temples in Agrigento, or excursions in Naro, Palma di Montechiaro.
N.B. optional excursions are not included in the participation fee.

Every Sunday **from July 21th to September 15th**

Participation Fee

The participation fee is € 350 for 1 week camp, € 600 for 2 weeks, € 750 for 3 weeks & € 800 for 4 weeks. To participate in more days than the duration of the week will be charged a daily fee of € 50.

Things to Bring

- Small backpack for personal belongings during activities
- Water bottle, flashlight and need for toilet
- Pillowcases and sheets (above & below) in addition to any sleeping bag
- Very important for archaeological activity is good to adopt long pants cotton sunhat, shoes anti-accident and health card
- Typical recipe of your country with doses & ingredients for 6 people

Please note Happening participation is open to scholars, students, volunteers, enthusiasts, researchers & experts. The participants age is 18 - 35. Underage can participate only if expressly authorized by parents & approved application after Skype® interview.

Academic credits are offered for participation in the Happening: 1 week 2 credits, 2 weeks 3 credits, 3 weeks 4 credits, 4 weeks 5 credits. For students of the University of Palermo, in particular students of Archaeology, Cultural Heritage & Classics degree courses is compulsory to participate 2 weeks for the acquisition of 3 credits. Furthermore, there is a 30% discount of the participation fee for them.
